



Should be installed either at/near front door or garage depending on how the house fronts the street to which it is assigned (street in the address)

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- (a) The developer, owner, occupant or person in charge of any dwelling unit, structure or use to which a number has been assigned shall be notified by the county of the number assigned to the dwelling unit, structure or use.
- (b) The developer, owner, occupant or person in charge of any dwelling unit, structure or use to which a number has been assigned shall cause the number of the dwelling unit, structure or use to be posted in designated locations depending upon the following conditions:
 - (1) If the mailbox is located on the same side of the street and adjacent to the driveway entrance or curb cut, the number shall be posted in two locations:
 - a. On the mailbox, as prescribed by United States Postal Service; and
 - b. Affixed to the front of the dwelling unit, structure or use.
 - (2) If the mailbox is not on the same side of the street and adjacent to the driveway entrance or curb cut, or if access is by means of a private road and the mailbox cannot be viewed from the public way, the number shall be posted at three locations:
 - a. On the mailbox, as prescribed by United States Postal Service Regulations; and
 - b. Affixed to the front of the dwelling unit, structure or use; and
 - c. On an aboveground sign attached to a wooden or vinyl support or steel or aluminum post or other object at the driveway entrance or curb cut. The post shall be located a minimum of one foot from any sidewalk, back of curb, or driveway. The numbers sign shall be a minimum of 42 inches and a maximum of 60 inches above ground level. Heavy metal pipes, concrete posts or potentially dangerous supports are prohibited.
 - (3) If there is no mail box, wherein the method of delivery is a centralized postal location in the community or center, the number shall be posted at two locations:
 - a. Affixed to the front of the dwelling unit, structure or use; and
 - b. On an aboveground sign attached to a wooden or vinyl support or steel or aluminum post or at the driveway entrance or curb cut. The post shall be located a minimum of one foot back from any sidewalk, back of curb, or driveway. The numbers sign shall be a minimum of 42 inches and a maximum of 60 inches above ground level. Heavy metal pipes, concrete posts or potentially dangerous supports are prohibited.
 - (4) In such cases where the structure number cannot be posted as required in subsections (b)(1)—(3) of this section, the number shall be posted as prescribed by the GIS Department after consultation with the fire marshal's office and the developer, owner, occupant or person in charge of the dwelling unit, structure or use.
- (c) The posted structure numbers or letters shall be Arabic numbers or alphabetical letters a minimum of four inches high with a minimum stroke width of one-half inch and shall be of a color that contrasts with their background.
- (d) This section does not preclude an individual from also numbering the entrance at the driveway or curb with reflective numbers set in a plaque on a concrete or masonry curb or with reflective painted numbers on a concrete or masonry curb.
- (e) It shall be the duty of the developer, owner, occupant or person in charge of the dwelling unit, structure or use upon affixing a new number, to remove any different number which might be mistaken for or confused with the number assigned to the structure by the GIS Department.
