Pool Rules

POOL HOURS: DAILY 7:00AM to 9:00PM

Summer means fun in the sun by the pool! The Mountain Crest Community Association pool is considered Swim at Your Own Risk.

The following pool rules are in place to make the community pool a fun and safe place for everyone to enjoy. Please review these rules and the rules posted at the pool and share them with your family and guests. Pool facilities are for the enjoyment of residents in good standing with the Association.

Violation of pool rules will result in fines and/or suspension of amenity privileges.

➤ COVID-19 WARNING

- CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) MAY BE PRESENT. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
 - ANYONE EXPERIENCING FLU LIKE SYMPTOMS MUST NOT ENTER
 - POOL AND AMENITY AREA RULES AND REGULATIONS
 - FOR USE OF AMENITIES DURING COVID -19 PANDEMIC AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE
 - USE AT OWN RISK. CORONAVIRUS COULD BE PRESENT.
 - 1. NO ONE EXPERIENCING FLU LIKE OR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS MAY ENTER ANY AMENITY AREA
 - 2. SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES SHALL APPLY TO ALL ASSOCIATION COMMON AREA AMENITIES. PLEASE MAINTAIN A DISTANCE OF AT LEAST 3 FEET APART FROM ONE ANOTHER AT ALL TIMES
 - 3. MASKS OR CLOTH FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL INDOOR AMENITIES AND ENCOURAGED FOR OUTDOOR AMENITIES
 - 4. GUESTS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME WITHIN THE COMMON AREA AMENITIES (Guest is any person that does not live in the home full time/non member of the household)
 - 5. AMENITY ACCESS CARDS AND GATE CODES WHERE APPLICABLE SHOULD BE NOT BE SHARED WITH ANYONE OUTSIDE OF THE FAMILY LIVING IN YOUR HOME.
- Proper swimming attire must be worn at all times; no thongs, no street clothes.
 - Swimmers under 15 yrs of age must not use the pool without an adult resident in attendance.
 - No Gum, Glass containers and other breakable items are not allowed in or around the pool area.
 - No food or drink in the pool.
 - No Smoking, Vaping, etc.
 - No Skateboards, bicycles, roller blades or similar are permitted in pool area
 - The entrance to the swimming area must remain locked at all times. This is an important safety precaution. Do not prop open doors and immediately close door if found propped open.
 - While in pool, swimmers in diapers must wear diapers AND plastic/rubber pants.
 - Diving is not permitted.
 - Pets are not permitted in pool, around pool deck or anywhere around the pool area.
 - Boisterous behavior and feats of daring exhibition that could jeopardize your personal safety and the safety of others are prohibited.
 - Spitting, spouting water from the mouth or blowing of the nose in the pool is prohibited.
 - Noise, such as audio equipment and/or voice levels, must be maintained at a minimum volume. Headphones and ear buds are encouraged.
 - To reduce the risk of communicable disease, patron who have been ill or who have experienced open cuts/sores within the past 48 hours are asked not to enter the pool.
 - Please shower/rinse off before entering the pool.
 - Please clean up behind yourself after using the restrooms. Report low supplies if needed. Do not flush anything other than toilet paper.
 - Swimming is prohibited after 9pm.
 - Pool will be closed after adding heavy doses of chemicals to the water as eye/skin damage could result.
 - Please help us maintain a clean environment in the pool and patio area. Dispose of all litter, cigarette butts and cans in trash containers. All personal items should be removed if unattended.

There is no lost and found storage bin.

- The Association and its Management is not responsible for loss of personal property.
- The safety equipment is for emergency use only. Please do not tamper or play with this equipment.

- **SLIDE RULES: Hours of Operation: May 13th - July 30th from 11am-6pm**
- Slide use is at your own risk.
- If the slide is turned off or the Aquatics Personnel /monitor is not present, the slide is closed.
- Aquatics Personnel/monitor is generally present only on weekends. Schedule changes to Daily 5/27-7/30.
- While scheduled for 2023, availability is subject to change with no notice.
- NO SWIMMING IN THE SLIDE AREA if there is no Aquatics Personnel present.
- Catching an individual at the slide is a safety hazard and is prohibited.
- The Aquatics Personnel /monitor has the authority to close the slide for any reason.
- Slide weight limit is 200 pounds.
- Slide should not be used by pregnant women, persons who are hearing impaired, persons with respiratory, neck/back problems or by persons who have recently undergone surgery or illness.
- Only one person at a time may go down the slide. No exceptions.
